The school was founded in 2018 through the hard work of parent leaders and community members advocating for better educational options for their children. The school currently serves grades TK-1 and will continue to grow until it becomes a full TK-4 elementary school. By fourth grade, our students will be prepared to thrive at one of our two KIPP middle schools in San Francisco. KIPP Bayview Elementary students apply their knowledge and skills through collaborative, real-world problem-solving using the design-thinking process to cultivate empathy, curiosity, and leadership. KIPP Bayview Elementary is one of 15 KIPP schools in the Bay Area and 224 KIPP schools nationally educating nearly 100,000 students on their path to and through college.

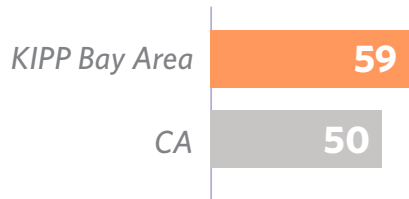

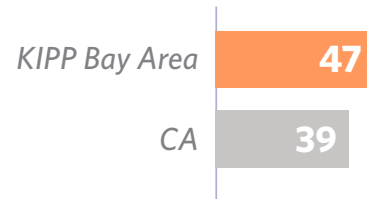

*% of students meeting or exceeding standards in Math**

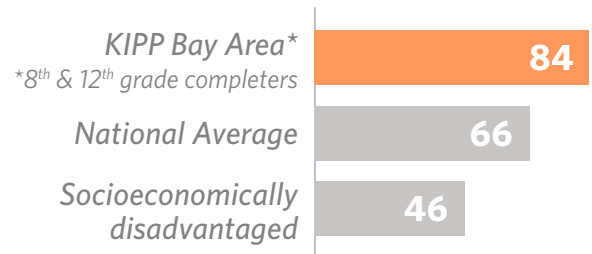
